Camp Policies and Things to Bring!

The following things are *not* permissible for Camp:

- **Short Shorts.** (Gym shorts, boxers, "Daisy Dukes", etc.) *Now, if you need a rule of thumb*, no one (boy or girl) will be allowed to wear shorts that cannot pass "The Camp" measuring test: "While standing with your arms straight down by your sides, fingers extended and palms against the outside of your thighs, the bottom of the cuff cannot be higher than the tip of your middle finger."
- **Mini-Skirts or Mini-Dresses.** "The bottom of the hem on all skirts and dresses will be no higher than the top of the knee cap when the girl is standing."
- **Tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, midriffs or bikini tops.** "The tail of all shirts must extend below the waistline of your pants or skirt. All shirts & tops must have sleeves."
- **Clothing with "inappropriate" advertising, messages, symbols or music groups.** If you have to ask if it is okay to wear, please do not wear it.
- **Two-piece swim suits or "skimpy" one-piece suits.** (Bikinis, tanks with low-cut necklines and high-cut leg openings, one-piece suit that from any angle appears to be a two-piece suit, speedo, etc.) If a girl only has the above type suit, she may wear it with a dark t-shirt over it. Boys must wear reasonable swim wear.
- **"PDA".** (Public Display of Affection) There shall be no hand holding, hugging, or kissing.
- **Alcohol, drugs, or tobacco of any kind will not be allowed in any form, with the exception of prescription & over-the-counter medications taken for legitimate reasons.**
- **Food or drinks allowed in dorms or sleeping areas.**
- **Profanity.** (Spoken, signed, or implied)
- **iPods, iPads, CD or MP3 players, radios, etc. (cell phones are NOT allowed)**
- **Girls will not be allowed in the boy's dorm at anytime.**

Expectations for Campers

- All campers must abide by the rules.
- All campers should be on time for all activities.
- All campers are to show respect for their fellow campers and the adults as well.
- Sour and negative attitudes are not acceptable.
- Cooperation is necessary.

The "Camp Director" has final say on interpretation of the rules and in determining infractions.

Things to Bring to Camp

- Bed linens or sleeping bag
- Towels and wash cloths
- Toilet articles
- Only clothes that meet the dress code
- Swimwear that meet the dress code
- Old sneakers suitable for swimming
- Bible
- Pencil and paper

Flip flops are not recommended. With the terrain we have at the camp, they are dangerous and unsuitable footwear.
